CANCELLATION POLICY:

A 50% Non-refundable deposit is due at time of booking. Cancellation of your trip must be made 60 days prior to your arrival. If you do not cancel within 60 days, or no-show, your credit card will be charged 100% of the total of your trip. The only exception is death or family emergency. In this event, we will do everything within our power to re-schedule your trip with mutually acceptable dates.

****Reservations are not confirmed and will not be held without a valid credit card number.**

THINGS PERTINENT TO THE HUNT

Normal temperatures for season:

- October - Very Mild 40 to 60 degrees average
- November - Moderate 25 to 50 degrees average
- December - Cold 10 to 35 degrees average
- January - Very Cold Below 0 to 25 degrees average

Clothing: Make sure to bring plenty of warm clothes; long underwear, warm coat, gloves, hip boots/waders, hat (drab colors or camouflage preferred), face netting optional.

Guns & Ammo: Be sure to bring a gun and ammo. Some people prefer to ship their ammo to the lodge a week or so before their hunt. Steel shot is required for waterfowl. #1's or #2's for Ducks. BBB or T-shot is recommended for Geese.

Rental Car: For those of you flying, you will need a rental car to get to the lodge and to get to your hunts. (An SUV or truck is highly recommended)

Duck and Goose Plucking: We have a bird processing facility on site, which is included in the "package" prices. The individual daily guided hunt prices do not include this service.

Don't Forget To Bring With You The Following That Apply To Your Hunt:

- Federal Duck Stamp (Signed across face of stamp) Purchased at Post Office
- Washington State Bird Permit
- Small Game Permit
- YOUR CAMERA!!!

Before your hunt, your guide will ask to see your license that will be needed. Make sure you have it with you.
